ORDER

For good cause shown, the Court hereby grants the parties' joint request to revise the case schedule as follows:


- **January 7, 2014:** Deposition of Bruce Pixley.
- **February 6, 2014:** Deadline for Delta's opposition to Plaintiffs' motion for sanctions, including any expert report, declaration or affidavit relied upon in the opposition.
- **Week of February 24, 2014:** Deposition of Eric Friedberg.
- **March 21, 2014:** Deadline for Plaintiffs' reply brief in support of motion for sanctions.

Nothing in this Order prejudices Plaintiffs from seeking leave from the Court to submit a rebuttal report, declaration, or affidavit with (or before) their reply brief.

In its order on Plaintiffs' motion for sanctions, the Court will issue a schedule for motions to exclude testimony relating to class certification and merits experts, summary judgment briefing, Plaintiffs' requested supplemental class

certification reply brief and Defendants' requested supplemental class certification sur-replies.
