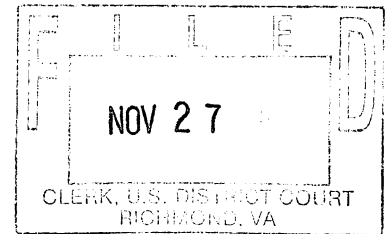

**ORDER**

For the reasons that will be set forth in a forthcoming Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby ORDERED that DEFENDANT JELD-WEN, INC.'S MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT ON COUNTS I AND IV OF PLAINTIFF STEVES AND SONS, INC.'S COMPLAINT (ECF No. 375) is denied, except to the extent that JELD-WEN seeks summary judgment on Steves' Clayton Act claim for damages based on future lost profits attributable to antitrust injury, an issue which the Court will resolve after the parties submit supplemental briefs pursuant to the Court's order (ECF No. 574).
