11:12 a.m. – Jury foreperson Alexander Noiseux informs the Court that what was read into the record by the Clerk is the jury's True Verdict.

11:13 a.m. – Plaintiff's counsel requests the jury be polled.

Question 1: Did Micron and/or Hynix agree with each other and/or Infineon and/or Samsung to fix RDRAM prices high and DDR prices low and/or restrict RDRAM output in order to prevent RDRAM from becoming the standard for computer memory? Three jurors answer yes. Nine jurors answer no.

Question 16: Did Micron and/or Hynix conspire with each other and/or Infineon and/or Samsung to disrupt an economic relationship between Rambus and Intel? Three jurors answer yes. Nine jurors answer no.
