

**FINDING OF “SATISFACTORY COOPERATION” OF DEFENDANT
SIOUXLAND CONCRETE COMPANY**

Upon Defendant Siouxland Concrete Company’s (Siouxland) motion, and for good cause shown, this Court finds that Siouxland, as an antitrust leniency applicant under the U.S. Department of Justice’s Antitrust Division Corporate Leniency Program, provided satisfactory cooperation in the instant action pursuant to the terms of Section 213(b) of the Antitrust Criminal Penalty Enhancement and Reform Act of 2004 (“ACPERA”). Pursuant to Section 213(a) of ACPERA, the damages recoverable against Siouxland for its wrongful conduct would be limited so that Siouxland would not be subject to treble damages or joint and several liability.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
