**ORDER**

Before the Court is Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Entry of Bond Amount, filed June 17, 2015 (Clerk's Dkt. #48).

Upon review of the motion, the Court hereby **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Entry of Bond Amount (Clerk's Dkt. #48). The Court finds that \$500.00 is an appropriate security amount in this case, based on the defendants' acceptance of the amount and the lack of evidence of harm to the defendants from compliance with the injunction.

Accordingly, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c), Plaintiffs shall post a bond of \$500.00 as security for the Court's Order Granting Plaintiffs' Application for a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction. (Clerk's Dkt. #44).
