

heretofore appealed to the Supreme Court of the United States from the Final Decree made by this Court in this cause on the 4th day of January, 1924, perpetually enjoining and restraining them, and each of them, as set forth in said Decree, and this cause having come on to be heard before the said Supreme Court of the United States at the October 1924 Term on the transcript of record, and having been argued by Counsel for the respective parties hereto and due deliberation having been had, the said Court filed its opinion and ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said Final Decree be reversed; and the said Supreme Court of the United States having remanded this cause to this Court with instructions

- 2. That the Final Decree made in this cause on the 4th day of January, 1924, be, and the same hereby is, in all respects vacated and annulled.
- 3. That the Petition and Bill of Complaint herein be, and the same hereby is, in all respects dismissed.
