ORDER APPROVING AMENDED FORM OF SUPERSEDEAS BOND

The Court has considered the defendant JSW Steel (USA) Inc.’s Letter Brief requesting approval of an amended form of supersedeas bond attached to the Letter Brief (electronically filed December 9, 2014). The Court, having reviewed the Letter Brief, the Amended Form of Supersedeas Bond in the amount of \$80,000,000, and the powers of attorney submitted by North American Specialty Insurance Company and Westport Insurance Corporation, as Co-Sureties, is of the opinion that the Amended Form of Supersedeas Bond should be and is hereby APPROVED, subject to the following modifications:

Promise to Pay

As a result of . . . all damages, costs, and interest awarded to MM Steel, L.P., by the amended final judgment in this action against JSW following the appeal of this matter up to the maximum liability hereinafter stated, but not exceeding the sum of \$80 million, if:



(c) JSW fails to pay the judgment awarded against it following . . .

It is ORDERED that defendant JSW Steel (USA) Inc., within three (3) days of the date of entry of this Order, file with the Court an Amended Form of Supersedeas Bond properly dated with modifications and executed by JSW, as principal, and North American Specialty Insurance Company and Westport Insurance Corporation, as Co-Sureties. The current stay of enforcement of the Amended Final Judgment is extended until 9:00 a.m., on the fourth day following the date of entry of this Order in the event no conforming bond is filed.
