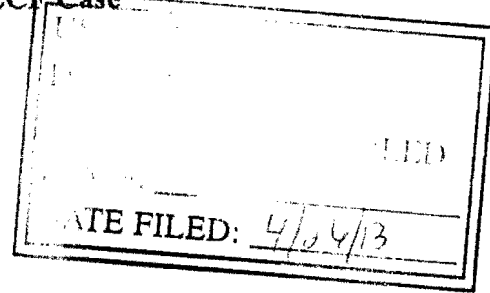

MASTER DOCKET AND CASE FILE NUMBER  
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR  
SUBSEQUENT RELATED ACTIONS

The above-captioned cases (the "Consolidated Actions") having been consolidated by Order dated April 24, 2013, ECF No. 38, and Susman Godfrey LLP having been appointed Interim Class Counsel by Order dated April 5, 2013, ECF No. 36, the Court orders as follows:

1. The Clerk will maintain a Master Docket under the style "*In re* NYC Bus Tour Antitrust Litigation" as Master Case File Number 13-CV-0711. The original of this Order shall

be filed by the Clerk on the Master Docket. Separate dockets shall also be maintained for each of the Consolidated Actions, and entries shall be made therein in accordance with the Clerk's regular procedures, except as modified by this Order.

2. Orders, pleadings, motions, and other documents bearing the caption "*In re* NYC Bus Tour Antitrust Litigation," when docketed and filed under the Master Case File Number, will be deemed to have been filed in each individual case to the extent applicable and will not be separately docketed or physically filed in such individual cases.


3. All orders, pleadings, motions, and other documents in the Consolidated Actions shall bear the caption: "*In re* NYC Bus Tour Antitrust Litigation." If generally applicable to all of the Consolidated Actions, they shall include in the caption the notation that they relate to "ALL CASES" and be filed and docketed only on the Master Docket.

4. A document that relates only to a specific case and that would not be of interest except to the parties directly affected by it—such as an amended complaint adding a party or a motion to dismiss a party—shall indicate in its caption the specific file number of the case to which it applies.

5. When a case that relates to the same subject matter as the Consolidated Actions is hereafter filed in this Court or transferred from another court (a "Subsequent Related Action"), the clerk shall (a) file copies of the Order appointing Interim Class Counsel, ECF No. 36, the consolidation Order, ECF No. 38, and this Order in the separate file for such Subsequent Related Action; (b) make an appropriate entry reflecting the filing of such Subsequent Related Action on the Master Docket; and (c) upon the first appearance of any new defendant(s) in such Subsequent Related Action, mail copies of the Order appointing Interim Class Counsel, ECF No. 36, the consolidation Order, ECF No. 38, and this Order to counsel for such new defendant(s).

6. The Order appointing Interim Class Counsel, ECF No. 36, the consolidation Order, ECF No. 38, and this Order shall govern all Subsequent Related Actions, unless a party to such a Subsequent Related Action files an application for relief on the Master Docket within fifteen (15) days after the date of the Master Docket entry reflecting the filing of such Subsequent Related Action.
