Francis's opinion that a patient admitted to plaintiff's hospital faces health risks if transported to defendant's hospital is admissible contingent upon an adequate foundation being presented; Francis's opinion about CON rules being unfair in Eugene and more logical in Portland is excluded; Francis's opinion that defendant "does not follow the rules" and obtained special legislation in expanding its Cottage Grove facility during the time that Francis worked for defendant is excluded, subject to an offer of proof being made by plaintiff; also excluded are any opinions from Francis and Orr that plaintiff is permitted to engage in otherwise-monopolistic conduct without violating antitrust laws because plaintiff lacks market power. Defendant's motion to exclude inflammatory descriptions of defendant's strategies when attempting to purchase land for its Riverbend site so that the sellers, Arlie & Co., wouldn't inflate the real estate prices is granted. Defendant's motion to exclude evidence of conduct outside of Oregon is granted. However, plaintiff would be permitted to introduce evidence of any adjudications or formal findings of fact establishing that defendant has violated federal antitrust laws in other states. Defendant's motion to exclude testimony from Rob Zako is granted. Defendant's motion to exclude certain aspects of testimony from plaintiff's witnesses Van Flandern and Scher is granted as follows: any opinions from these witnesses that (1) a preferred insurance plan should cover both hospitals in a two-hospital community; (2) stress affects pregnancies; and (3) other pregnant women made comments to Van Flandern in a prenatal swim class are excluded. Plaintiff will be required to establish the relevance of any other testimony from these witnesses before they will be permitted to testify. Defendant's motion to exclude testimony from Dr. Michael Tripp is granted only as to testimony that would constitute hearsay. Plaintiff's Motion to Exclude Evidence of Triad Transactions (#173) is GRANTED. Plaintiff's Motion in Limine raising lay witness issues (#189) is DENIED except as follows: evidence of defendant's benevolent role in the community is excluded.
