PROBATION

The defendant is hereby placed on probation for a term of 5 years.

FINE

The defendant shall pay a fine in the total amount of \$ 3,300,000 as follows:

- a. \$750,000 within ten days of sentencing;
- b. \$400,000 at the one year sentencing anniversary;
- c. \$400,000 at the two year sentencing anniversary;
- d. \$400,000 at the three year sentencing anniversary;
- e. \$400,00 at the four year sentencing anniversary,
- f. 950,000 at the five year sentencing anniversary;
