**AMENDED PARTIAL JUDGMENT AS
TO DEFENDANT NINGBO SUNNY
ELECTRONIC CO. LTD.**

This Order amends the partial judgment on the jury’s verdict (Dkt. No. 501) (the “Verdict”) in favor of Plaintiff Optronic Technologies, Inc. (“Orion”) against Defendant Ningbo Sunny Electronic Co. Ltd. (“Defendant”) as to Orion’s claims for damages under Section 1 of the Sherman Act, Section 2 of the Sherman Act, Section 7 of the Clayton Act, and the California Cartwright Act, Cal. Bus. & Profs. Code § 16600, *et seq.* (collectively, the “Damages Claims”) that the Court entered on December 5, 2019. Dkt. No. 518.

Judgment is entered on the Damages Claims in the amount of \$52,030,371.73 in accordance with the Verdict’s award of \$16,800,000 in damages as trebled pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 15(a), with \$3,100,000 then deducted to offset Orion’s Settlement and Supply Agreement with Defendant’s settling coconspirators, and with \$4,730,371.73 then added to account for Orion’s attorneys’ fees and costs (Dkt. No. 629), with post-judgment interest thereon from the date of entry of the judgment at the applicable federal post-judgment interest rate until paid in full.

The Court does not enter judgment and reserves jurisdiction over Orion’s claims for equitable relief, including its claims under California Unfair Competition Law (Bus. & Profs.

1 Code §§ 17200 *et seq.*) and Section 16 of the Clayton Act. This Judgment also is without
2 prejudice to the Court’s jurisdiction to enter judgment upon application by Plaintiff against
3 Defendants Meade Instruments, Corp. and Sunny Optics, Inc. upon lifting of the automatic stay
4 imposed by their respective bankruptcy filings.
