1 The United States is filing a Corrected Statement of Interest to amend a
2 sentence on page 17 of its filing. Originally, the sentence stated:

3 The “quick-look analysis” applies only in rare cases “when the great likelihood
4 of anticompetitive effects can easily be ascertained,” and “it is not implausible”
5 that procompetitive benefits would outweigh harm to competition. *Cal. Dental
Ass’n v. FTC*, 526 U.S. 756, 770, 775 (1999).

6 The matter being referenced as “not implausible” in *California Dental
7 Association*, however, was the defendant’s “prediction” that any harm to competition
8 caused by the challenged restraint would be outweighed by procompetitive benefits.
9 526 U.S. at 775. Due to the “plausibility of procompetitive justifications” offered by
10 the defense, the Supreme Court concluded quick-look analysis should not apply in that
11 case. *Id.* at 775-76. Accordingly, to more accurately reflect the Court’s holding and
12 its use of the double negative, the United States has modified the above-quoted
13 sentence to state:

14 The “quick-look analysis” applies only in rare cases “when the great likelihood
15 of anticompetitive effects can easily be ascertained,” and it is “implausible” that
16 procompetitive benefits would outweigh harm to competition. *Cal. Dental
Ass’n v. FTC*, 526 U.S. 756, 770, 775-76 (1999).

17 The United States’ Corrected Statement of Interest also eliminates some small
18 typographical errors that do not alter the substance or pagination of the original
19 Statement.
