Order filed and entered allowing Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis et al, an appeal to the Supreme Court of United States on the terms and conditions specified in said order from the decree of Feby 8th, 1923 & order filed and entered extending said appellants time for lodging narrative statement of evidence as required by Equity Rule #75 to May 20, 1923, and also extending to said date appellants time for filing praecipe, etc.

Petition of Terminal Railroad Association, et al, for allowance of appeal to Supreme Court of the United States from Decree of February 8th, 1923, filed, together with joint assignment of errors of said petitioners. Order of Hon Willis Van Devanter, Justice of the Supreme Court, allowing such appeal, as well as supersedeas of decree upon petitioners giving bonds specified in order received, filed and entered. Twenty-three (23) supersedeas bonds of petitioners as approved received and filed.

April 6

Copy of citation issued by Supreme Justice Van Devanter with acknowledgments of service filed.

April 24

Praecipe for transcript of Terminal Railroad Association of St. Louis, et al, together with election as to printing of record on appeal, filed by said Terminal Railroad Association, et al. Narrative statement of evidence under Equity Rule 75 lodged by appellants, together with separate acknowledgment of service by appellees of copy of such narrative statement and copy of praecipe for transcript as well as acknowledgment of service of notice of date on which such narrative statement of evidence will be submitted for approval.

May 11

Narrative statement of evidence to be incorporated in transcript on appeal of Terminal Railroad Association, et al., from decree of Feby 8th, 1923 as approved by Circuit Judge Sanburn, received and filed.

Nov. 24

Mandate of U. S. Supreme Court on appeal of Baltimore & Ohio Southern Railway Company from decree entered February 8th, 1923, received, filed and entered.

1925

April 15

Motion of Terminal Railroad Association, et al for entry of decree under Mandate of Supreme Court of United States filed in notice of presentation of such motion.

June 1

Final decree under Mandate of Supreme Court of United States on issues raised by petiton of Missouri Kansas & Texas Railroad Co., et al., signed by Circuit Judges Sanborn, Stone & Lewis, received, filed and entered.
