**DEFENDANT INTUIT INC.'S DESCRIPTION AND CERTIFICATION OF

Pursuant to Section 2(g) of the Antitrust Procedures and Penalties Act, 15 U.S.C. § 16(g), Defendant Intuit Inc. (“Intuit” or “Defendant”), by its attorneys, submits the following certification regarding all written or oral communications by or on behalf of Intuit with any officer or employee of the United States concerning or relevant to the Proposed Final Judgment. 2. On October 29, November 5, November 6, November 11, and November 24, 2020 Mr. Goodarzi spoke with Department of Justice Assistant Attorney General Makan Delrahim concerning a proposal for a consent judgment.

3. Between October 29 and November 24, 2020, Mr. Goodarzi communicated in writing with Mr. Delrahim concerning a proposal for a consent judgment.

Intuit certifies that the requirements of 15 U.S.C. § 16(g) have been complied with and that this description of communications by or on behalf of Intuit and required to be reported under 15 U.S.C. § 16(g) is true and complete.
