Counsel,

It has come to our attention that multiple invoices from the Monitoring Trustee, which were finalized and accepted by ASSA ABLOY or its counsel in December, are long past due. We are obviously not a party to ASSA's engagement agreement with the Monitoring Trustee and have no desire to become involved in any of the details of billing disputes that may arise under that agreement. That said, we want to reiterate that we view payment of the Monitoring Trustee's costs and expenses as an important part of ASSA ABLOY's obligations under the Final Judgment, and therefore we encourage ASSA ABLOY to bring its payment of the Monitoring Trustee's invoices current as soon as possible.
