1 Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission's Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining
2 Order came before this Court for hearing on _____, 2023. Having considered the
3 Motion and given the parties notice and an opportunity to be heard, the Court hereby GRANTS
4 the Motion and ORDERS as follows: Defendants Intercontinental Exchange, Inc., and Black
5 Knight, Inc., shall not close or consummate their proposed transaction until after 11:59 p.m.
6 Eastern Time on the second (2nd) business day after the Court rules on the FTC's motion for a
7 preliminary injunction under Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act, or a date set
8 by the Court, whichever is later.

9 Defendants Intercontinental Exchange, Inc., and Black Knight, Inc., shall take any and all
10 necessary steps to prevent any of their officers, directors, domestic or foreign agents, divisions,
11 subsidiaries, affiliates, partnerships, or joint ventures from closing or consummating, directly or
12 indirectly, the proposed transaction.
