Upon the Declaration of Anjelica Sarmiento in Support of the Proposed Order to Show Cause For Motion For Temporary Restraining Order (“Motion For Temporary Restraining Order”) and Exhibits, Memorandum of Law in Support of Motion For Temporary Restraining Order, Declaration of Scott Syms in Support of Motion For Temporary Restraining Order, and Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission’s Complaint for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction Pursuant to Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act in the above-captioned matter, it is hereby ORDERED that the above-named Defendants show cause before this Court, at Room 619, in the ~~Daniel Patrick Moynihan~~ Thurgood Marshall United States Courthouse New York, ~~500 Pearl Street~~ 40 Foley Square, Manhattan, New York, NY 10007, on July 20, 2023, at 9:30 A.M. a.m./p.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why an order should not be issued pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure enjoining Defendant IQVIA Holdings Inc. and Defendant Propel Media, Inc. (together with IQVIA Holdings Inc., “Defendants”) from consummating the proposed acquisition after 11:59 p.m. on July 21, 2023.

Notice of this motion has been given to Defendants' attorneys by Plaintiff's counsel, and a reasonable effort has been made to reach agreement. Defendants currently oppose the Motion for Temporary Restraining Order. Plaintiff and Defendants are continuing to meet and confer to see if the parties can reach an agreement regarding a stipulation related to a temporary restraining order. If after meeting and conferring, the parties can reach an agreement, Plaintiff will update the Court accordingly.

A proposed temporary restraining order is attached.


