- December 13, 2024: Defendants' opposition to Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction
- January 10, 2025: Plaintiffs reply in support of their motion for preliminary injunction

Defendants' responsive pleading deadline is extended to 30 days after the resolution of Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction.

Additionally, the Court will set a status conference within two days of its ruling on the FTC's motion for preliminary injunction in Civil Action No. 4:24-cv-02508.
