Under Evidence Code, section 452(h), the Court may take judicial notice of "[f]acts and propositions that are not reasonably subject to dispute and are capable of immediate and accurate determination by resort to sources of reasonably indisputable accuracy." (Evid. Code, § 452(h); *see also Pereda v. Atos Jiu Jitsu LLC* (Nov. 23, 2022) -- Cal.App.5th --, 2022 WL 17174558, *1 fn. 1 [judicial notice may be taken of a "website's content—separate and apart from the truth of that content" because it "is something 'not reasonably subject to dispute and [is] capable of immediate and accurate determination by resort to sources of reasonably indisputable accuracy"]; *Scott v. JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A.* (2013) 214 Cal.App.4th 743, 751 ["a demurrer may be sustained where judicially noticeable facts render the pleading defective, and allegations in the pleading may be disregarded if they are contrary to facts judicially noticed" (citation omitted)]). The fact that the articles identified as Exhibits 1-3 were published is not reasonably subject to dispute and are capable of immediate and accurate determination.
