The court directs the United States Solicitor General, within one week of this order, to identify by name the officials in the “interested components of the federal government” that he consulted with, the nature of the consultation, and the meaning of the statement in the Solicitor General’s letter that the Solicitor General’s amicus curiae brief “reflects the views of the United States.”

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Solicitor General shall submit a copy of the amicus curiae brief of the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, filed in the district court, to which the Solicitor General’s letter refers.
